Committee Vacancies

We have two committee vacancies and are pleased that expressions of interest have been received from two GRA members. We will communicate more information in due course.

"GRA Self-Help": Managing the Workload

Paul Crocker, GRA Secretary, explained that there are an unprecedented number of issues currently affecting the village and immediate surrounding area at the present time. The GRA committee receive many hundreds of E-mails from villagers requesting the GRA's help. In reality, the GRA voluntary Committee do not have enough time to deal with all these issues. We recognise that some issues are important and, are about to launch a new initiative, "GRA Self-Help". If the GRA Committee feels a particular issue is worth pursuing, then we'll E-mail out to our E-mail membership to ask who wants to get involved in the project, to run it with the approval of GRA. If there is insufficient interest, the project will be abandoned. The group formed to manage the project will be responsible for managing the whole project, including financing, publicity and campaigning.

20-mph Village Centre Speed Limit

Following on from the previous report, it is likely that the first "GRA Self-Help" campaign, to be managed outside of the GRA formal structure, will be the 20-mph speed limit village campaign, which we have had to postpone due to resources being committed on the Common Public Enquiry. We have a few people who have previously expressed an interest in being part of this campaign and we'll circulate more detail as soon as we are able to.

Greenway House

Many residents have contacted us regarding the National Trusts plans to hold weddings at Greenway House, with concerns regarding over-commercialisation and fears that the volume of weddings will increase with a return of the accompanying traffic problems. At the time of publication, we understand that South Hams Council is looking into complaints received regarding the proposed change of use.

Residents Against Golf Club Sell-off R.A.G.S.

A Legal Battle Begins

- Submission of a Planning Application by Bloor Homes is yet to take place. It has been delayed by a series of Council Meetings urging the Mayor to reconsider his decision to remove Covenants in order to allow building.
- 27 Councillors voted recently in support of RAGS cause and urged the Mayor not to sign away Covenants which prevent building on the Golf Course. Only 4 Councillors voted in support of the Mayor's decision. But he remains adamant that "The Mayor is not for turning".
- This position is not unexpected given the Mayor's uncompromising stance throughout the last 12 months, since the RAGS campaign began.
- Both Torbay MPs have also supported RAGS campaign and have urged the Mayor not to sign without a significant mandate from the Council, and particularly not so near to the end of his term of office as Mayor – all to no avail.
- RAGS continues to hold to its conviction that the Mayor's decision has been improperly and unlawfully made, which is also the opinion of our legal advisors.
- Legal letters have been sent to Torbay Council detailing our claims in this respect.
- Despite concerted efforts by RAGS to find a solution via Torbay Council's legal department, no progress has been made so far, and so RAGS has advised the Council that it intends to apply to the High Court to have the Mayor's decision "quashed" so that the Covenants remain in place for the foreseeable future.
- This Legal process is very expensive and may take a number of months, possibly more than a year to complete. However, it is one which we feel to be fully justified, in order to protect our precious green spaces.
- It is believed to be unlikely that a Planning Application will be submitted by Bloor Homes whilst this legal challenge is underway.
- In the longer term, the success of RAGS campaign will almost certainly depend upon who will be the next Mayor.
- Mayor Bye continues to emphasise the importance of building houses, in a "big way" in order to attract government subsidises in future years. He also claims that this is more important than the voice of local residents.
- Please vote wisely on the 5th May and do not vote for Nick Bye unless you want the Golf Course development to go ahead.

Effects of the Equality Act 2010

There has been a new development in Employment Law recently. A new piece of legislation was enacted by the Government when The Equality Act came into force on 1st October 2010 and has far reaching implications.

The purpose of the Equality Act is to harmonise discrimination law and to strengthen the law to support progress on equality.

Employers and employees alike need to be aware of the new Equality Act, which requires employers to adopt new procedures in relation to candidate selection in particular. The Act has been billed as something of a tidying up exercise, bringing together nine separate pieces of legislation.

One change is that the Act prohibits a prospective employer from asking a candidate about their health before offering them a job, with a small number of exceptions. There are a number of other important changes!

Existing staff may need to consider their behaviour, as actions and statements made previously, that might have been acceptable under the old legislation, may now be deemed contrary to the provisions of the new Act!
